#### Private Health Insurance










#### Direct Purchase Health Insurance









#### Trends in Medicare Enrollment and Reimbursements







Reimbursements Per Medicare Enrollee










Physician Reimbursements Per Medicare Enrollee







Home Health Reimbursements Per Medicare Enrollee







Medicare Enrollees

MEDICARE ENROLLEES

Medicare Enrollees in Dawson County, TX were 1,633 in 2014, but 1,736 in 2013. These numbers represent a 7.58% growth during that year. Medicare Enrollees in Dawson County, TX are \$602 less than the national average. Medicare is a Federal program which provides health benefits to older Americans.

In 2014, the Medicare enrollees in Dawson County, TX between the ages of 65 and 75 had 113 eye exams, 172 hemoglobin tests, and 158 lipid tests as part of their diabetes care. Here is a breakdown of each test by race as a percentage of enrollees with diabetes.

#### Preventative Women's Health Services


