

Coming soon: Tea2Go TeaN'ergy

Construction should begin soon on a Tea2Go TeaN'ergy location in Lamesa.

Local builder Jordan Addison plans to both build and operate the franchise which, as the name indicates, specializes in a wide array of tea and energy drinks.

"I'm hoping to break ground soon, so we can be open this summer," Addison

said this past week.

The store will be located at 402 N. Dallas Ave., where Eiland Lumber was located for many years before the building was torn down last November.

"We're doing a ground-up new construction," Addison said, noting the design work is nearing completion.

The building is expected to cover about 1,500 square

feet and include both a drive-thru and an indoor sitting area for customers who want to enjoy their drinks at the location.

Addison said they also will be selling ice and reverse osmosis drinking water for refilling bottles up to five gallons in size.

"I think it will be popular," Addison said of the business. "I think it will be

good for the town."

Based in Lubbock, Tea2Go TeaN'ergy currently has 25 locations across the Texas, spread from Amarillo to Edinburg and El Paso to the Houston area. Another 20 locations are currently in the planning stages, according to the company website.

"They're really growing," Addison said.
